Housing Information

If you are traveling from out of town and you requested a motel room, your housing cost will be covered by NM EPSCoR for Thursday and Friday nights. Our lodging is at the Best Western Socorro, 1100 N. California St., Socorro, NM; 575-838-0556, bestwesternsocorro@yahoo.com, located at the north end of Socorro on the east side of California St, our main street in town, just south of McDonald's. There is an indoor pool and jacuzzi, free wireless internet, 24-hour exercise room, and free continental breakfast each morning at the motel.

IMMEDIATELY, contact the motel directly to make reservations in **Nano Teacher Workshop** Room Block, arranged by Vannetta Perry. You will pay for your room, \$85/night (plus tax), \$190.18/two nights, including tax, then be reimbursed following completion of the full workshop.
