

Presenting at New Mexico Research Symposium

The 2021 NMRS poster competition will be 100% virtual with PDF files posted on the NM Research Symposium program website and available for viewing between November 8 and December 31, 2021. Please note, synchronous participation is required for the poster session on Tuesday, November 9th from 4-5 pm via an online platform. All student posters will be entered into the poster competition and eligible to earn prizes in undergraduate and graduate categories. Poster judging will take place asynchronously and you will not be required to speak to the judges. Posters will be judged over the course of the week with winners announced at the closing remarks on Friday, November 12th.

Poster Session abstract submissions are **due by midnight on October 11, 2021**. Presenters will be **notified by October 18** of acceptance/non-acceptance and provided additional instructions for poster submission. For those whose abstract is accepted, the deadline for submitting a digital file (PDF format) of the poster will be **October 29**.

All accepted abstracts will be published in the *2021 New Mexico Journal of Science*. By submitting an abstract, you are granting NMAS and NM EPSCoR permission to publish it in the abstract compilation and to disseminate it electronically.

Abstract Format

Your abstract should contain the following elements:

- Body of the Abstract: General topic statement; Problem addressed; Summary of state of the field; Research methods; Results; Implication/impact
Abstracts are limited to 500 words, inclusive of key words.
- Keywords (up to five)

Virtual Poster Format

- Posters will be accepted in pdf format only, with a maximum file size of 32 MB.
- Use the following convention to name your poster file: Last name, First name, event, and year. Example: **lastname_firstname_NMRS_2021.pdf**
