

## **Presenting at New Mexico Research Symposium**

The 2022 NMRS poster competition will in-person. All student posters will be entered into the poster competition and eligible to earn prizes in undergraduate and graduate categories. Poster judging will take place from 10:30-noon where you will stand beside your poster and interact with judges and attendees. Poster winners will be announced at the awards ceremony starting at 2:45 pm.

Poster Session abstract submissions are **due by midnight on October 14, 2022**. Presenters will be **notified by October 21st** of acceptance/non-acceptance and provided additional instructions for poster submission.

All accepted abstracts will be published in the *2022 New Mexico Journal of Science*. By submitting an abstract, you are granting NMAS and NM EPSCoR permission to publish it in the abstract compilation and to disseminate it electronically.

### **Abstract Format**

Your abstract should contain the following elements:

- Body of the Abstract: General topic statement; Problem addressed; Summary of state of the field; Research methods; Results; Implication/impact  
Abstracts are limited to 500 words, inclusive of key words.
- Keywords (up to five)
